## ACDC LICENCE COMPETENCIES

A commercial operator's licence is required before a person can apply herbicides from ground equipment on land that they or their relatives do not own or occupy. This licence is issued by the Agricultural Chemicals Distribution Control (ACDC) Board and is issued for a three or one year term.

Required Units of Competence :

- AHCPGM301 Control weeds
- AHCCHM307 Prepare and apply chemicals to control pests, weeds and diseases
- AHCCHM304 Transport and store chemicals

These 'Units of Competence' are known as the 'approved accreditation.'
